FUNDING IN ALBERTA, 2000-2001

- In 2000-2001, the Canada Council for the Arts provided grants worth \$7.4 million to the arts in Alberta.
- In addition to grants, almost \$390,000 in payments was provided to 649 authors through the Public Lending Right Program¹.
- This brings the total amount of Canada Council funding to Alberta to almost \$7.8 million.
- The Council awarded \$6.1 million to 133 arts organizations and \$1.2 million to 129 artists.
- Grants were awarded in every discipline – dance, music, theatre, visual arts, media (film, video and new media) and writing and publishing. The largest amount of funding was awarded both to the theatre and music disciplines (\$1.8 million each) followed by visual arts (\$1.1 million).
- Over \$2.8 million in Council funding went to artists and arts organizations in Edmonton, making up of over 38% of funding going to the province. Calgary received \$3.3 million, making up almost 45% of the total. The remaining 28 communities receiving Canada Council funding in 2000-2001 had grants totalling over \$1.2 million (17% of the total).
- 41 artists and arts professionals from Alberta served as peer assessors in 2000-2001, making up 6.8% of all peer assessors.
- Alberta artists and arts organizations received 7.03% of Canada Council funding. In comparison, the province makes up 8.4% of culture workers and 9.7% of the Canadian population.
- According to the 1996 Census, there were almost 40,000 culture workers in Alberta, including 10,705 artists.

ALBERTA ORGANIZATIONS FUNDED BY THE CANADA COUNCIL, 2000-2001

Murk Puppet Theatre in Calgary received a \$7,000 Theatre Production Project Grant from the Canada Council for the Arts in 2000-2001. The company sought the grant to fund the mounting of an original, experimental work to be included in their season. This work seeks to expand the genre by using puppets that cross boundaries into painting, dance, mask, set-design and conventional objects. The show is 'The Portrait', a cross between a Grimm's fairy tale, a Punch and Judy show and a Shakespearean tragedy. The show made its debut at the 'One Yellow Rabbit High Performance Rodeo' in 2000 and is expected to tour Canada.

The **Aboriginal Arts Program at the Banff Centre for the Arts** received a total of \$135,000 in funding from the Canada Council in 2000-2001. The Aboriginal Arts Program applied a \$15,000 Media Arts Development Project Grant towards the development of a project entitled "Aboriginal Radio on the Internet: Aboriginal Streams". The project is a workshop for Aboriginal artists, radio producers and radio production groups interested in using streamed media as a means of artistic presentation, communication and exchange. The initiative builds on four years of successful Aboriginal New Media workshops at The Banff Centre including think tanks on authoring systems and languages as well as the creation of an Aboriginal Internet network.

Calgary based **Decidedly Jazz Danceworks** received a total of \$52,800 in Canada Council funding in 2000-2001. A \$17,800 Dance Touring Grant was awarded to facilitate the company's tour to Edmonton and Banff. This tour marks the fifth consecutive year that the company has toured to the two cities. The production "Evanescence" was an immense success, combining the work of their Artistic Director, Vicki Adams Willis' with the choreography of two guest choreographers. In addition, critical in-roads were made with respect to marketing to new audiences and establishing a stronger alliance with Edmonton's Jazz City Festival.

AIDE FINANCIÈRE ACCORDÉE À L'ALBERTA POUR L'ANNÉE 2000-2001

- En 2000-2001, le Conseil des Arts a octroyé 7,4 millions de dollars en subventions au domaine des arts en Alberta.
- Outre les subventions, près de 390 000 \$ en paiements ont été versés à 649 auteurs par l'entremise du Programme du droit de prêt public.
- Le financement total du Conseil en Alberta s'élève donc à près de 7,8 millions de dollars.
- Le Conseil des Arts a versé 6,1 millions de dollars à 133 organismes artistiques et 1,2 million de dollars à 129 artistes.
- L'aide du Conseil a touché toutes les disciplines – danse, musique, théâtre, arts visuels, arts médiatiques (cinéma, vidéo et nouveaux médias) et lettres et édition. La plus grande part de l'aide a été accordée aux disciplines du théâtre et de la musique (1,8 million de dollars chacune) et aux arts visuels (1,1 million de dollars).
- Le Conseil a octroyé plus de 2,8 millions de dollars en subventions aux artistes et aux organismes artistiques d'Edmonton, ce qui représente près de 38 p. 100 de l'aide accordée à la province. Calgary a reçu 3,3 millions de dollars, soit près de 45 p. 100 de l'aide totale. En 2000-2001, le Conseil a attribué plus de 1,2 millions de dollars à 28 autres collectivités de l'Alberta (17 p. 100 du total).
- En 2000-2001, 41 artistes et professionnels des arts albertains ont accepté d'être membres de comités d'évaluation par les pairs, ce qui représente 6,8 p. 100 de tous les pairs évaluateurs auxquels le Conseil a fait appel.
- Les artistes et les organismes artistiques de l'Alberta ont reçu 7,03 p. 100 du financement accordé par le Conseil des Arts. Pour fins de comparaison, la province compte 8,4 p. 100 des travailleurs du secteur culturel et 9,7 p. 100 de la population canadienne.
- Selon le Recensement de 1996, l'Alberta compte près de 40 000 travailleurs du secteur culturel dont 10 705 artistes.

ORGANISMES ALBERTAINS AIDÉS PAR LE CONSEIL DES ARTS EN 2000-2001

En 2000-2001, le **Murk Puppet Theatre** de Calgary a reçu du Conseil des Arts une subvention de projet en production théâtrale de 7 000 \$. La compagnie avait demandé cette subvention afin de financer la production d'une œuvre originale et expérimentale qu'elle souhaitait inclure à son programme de la saison. Cette œuvre, qui cherche à élargir le genre théâtral, utilise des marionnettes pour faire éclater les frontières entre la peinture, la danse, le masque, les décors et les objets conventionnels. Le spectacle, intitulé *The Portrait*, est un mélange des contes de Grimm, du Punch and Judy Show et d'une tragédie shakespearienne. Le spectacle a été primé au *One Yellow Rabbit* du *High Performance Rodeo* de 2000 et devrait être présenté en tournée au Canada.

En 2000-2001, l'**Aboriginal Arts Program du Banff Centre for the Arts** a reçu du Conseil des Arts du Canada un total de 135 000 \$ en subventions. Le Aboriginal Arts Program avait fait une demande de subvention de projet de développement en arts médiatiques de 15 000 \$ pour un projet intitulé *Aboriginal Radio on the Internet : Aboriginal Streams*. Le projet, sous forme d'atelier de travail, s'adresse aux artistes, aux producteurs de radio et aux groupes de production radiophonique autochtones qui s'intéressent aux médias en voie continue, en tant que moyen de présentation, de communication et d'échanges artistiques. L'initiative vient compléter quatre années d'excellents ateliers de travail en arts médiatiques pour Autochtones au Banff Art Centre ainsi que des groupes de réflexion portant sur la création de systèmes, de langues et d'un réseau Internet autochtone.

En 2000-2001, **Decidedly Jazz Danceworks**, compagnie de danse de Calgary, a reçu 52 800 \$ en subventions du Conseil des Arts. Une subvention de tournée en danse de 17 800 \$ lui a été octroyée afin de l'aider à effectuer, pour une cinquième année consécutive, sa tournée dans les villes d'Edmonton et de Banff. La production *Evanescence* s'est avéré un immense succès, combinant le travail de Vicki Adam Willis, directrice artistique de la compagnie, à la composition de deux chorégraphes invités. En outre, d'importantes percées ont été réalisées sur le plan du rayonnement auprès de jeunes publics et la consolidation de l'alliance avec le Jazz City Festival d'Edmonton.
